

The Bible (Amplified with restored name)

(Psalm of David asking YAHUAH for protection & comfort)

Psalm 23:1-6

[1] YAHUAH ELOYHIM is my Shepherd [to feed, guide, and shield me], I shall not lack.

[2] YAHUAH ELOYHIM is He, who makes me lie down in [fresh, tender] green pastures; YAHUAH ELOYHIM leads me beside the still and restful waters. [Rev. 7:17.]

[3] YAHUAH ELOYHIM is He, who refreshes and restores my life; YAHUAH ELOYHIM leads me in the paths of righteousness [uprightness and right standing with Him—not for my earning it, but] for His name's sake.

[4] Yes, though I walk through the [deep, sunless] valley of the shadow of death, I will not fear or dread no evil, for You YAHUAH ELOYHIM are with me; Your rod [to protect] and Your staff [to guide], they comfort me.

[5] You YAHUAH ELOYHIM prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You YAHUAH ELOYHIM anoint my head with oil; my [brimming] cup runs over.

[6] Surely only YAHUAH ELOYHIM's goodness, mercy, and unfailing love shall follow me all the days of my life, and through the length of my days the house of YAHUAH ELOYHIM [and His presence] shall be my dwelling place.
