## PSALM 27

## Amplified Bible Version \& Restored Names

YAHUAH is my Light and my Salvation, whom shall I fear? YAHUAH is the Strength my life; of whom shall I be afraid? When the wicked, even my enemies and my foes, came upon me to eat up my flesh, they stumbled and fell. Though a host should encamp against me, my heart shall not fear; though war should rise against me, in this will I be confident. One thing have I asked of YAHUAH, that will I seek, inquire for, and [insistently] require: that I may dwell in the house of YAHUAH [in His presence] all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of YAHUAH and to meditate, consider, and inquire in His temple.

For in the day of evil [and trouble] He shall hide me in His cukkah [shelter]; in the secret place of His Tabernacle shall He hide me; He shall set me high upon a rock. And now shall my head be lifted up above my enemies round about me; therefore will I will offer in His Tabernacle sacrifices of joy [shouts of praises]; I will sing, yea, I will sing praises to YAHUAH. Hear, O YAHUAH, when I cry with my voice aloud; have mercy also upon me, be gracious to me and answer me! When You said, Seek ye My face [to inquire for and require My presence]; my heart said unto You, Your face, YAHUAH, will I seek, [inquire for, and require of necessity and on the authority of Your Word].

Hide not Your face from me; put not Your servant away in anger, You have been my help; leave me not, neither forsake me, O ELOHAI of my Yeshuah/ Salvation. When my father and my mother forsake me, then YAHUAH will take me up. Teach me Your way, O YAHUAH, and lead me in a plain path because of my enemies. Deliver me not over unto the will of my enemies: for false witnesses are risen up against me; and such as breathe out cruelty. I had fainted, unless I had believed to see the goodness of YAHUAH in the land of the living! Wait on EL-YAHUAH; be of good courage and He shall strengthen your heart: wait, I say, on EL-YAHUAH.
