PSALM 81:7 - Meditation



(A Loving Father desires obedience form his children)

Remarks: As a loving Father desires obedience form his children, so our **ABBA YAHUAH** desires obedience and faith in him to always provide and protect us.

Exodus 17:3-4, shows that Israel was proved at the waters of Meribah; **YAHUAH** proved Israel by withholding water from them to test Israel’s heart, and to show whether his people would put their faith and confidence in **HIM, YAHUAH** their Elohiym.

PSALM 81:7

“You called in trouble, and I delivered you; I answered you in the secret place of thunder: I proved you at the waters of Meriyvah. Celah.”

secret place

- Psalm 119:114, “Thou art my **hiding place and my shield**: I hope in thy WORD.”

- Psalm 27:5, “For **in the time of trouble he shall hide me in his pavilion: in the secret of his tabernacle shall he hide me**; he shall set me up upon a rock.”

- Psalm 32:7, “**Thou art my hiding place; thou shalt preserve me from trouble**; thou shalt compass me about with songs of deliverance. Selah.”

PSALM 81:7 - Meditation

YAHUAH says to Israel, you called my Name for deliverance when you were afflicted in Egypt’s (bondage), And It is I, YAHUAH who delivered Israel from affliction and bondage onto My Salvation; With My Almighty Power, I sheltered/ covered you in the thunder cloud of judgement and I answered your Cry for deliverance, with judgement of the plagues upon Egypt, parting of the Red Sea, a cloud by day, a fire by night and wonders and marvels. I tested your hearts (for ME) that showed/reveal your transgression thru the murmuring of your mouth, I tested thy faith and obedience to MY WORD by miracles.

of thunder

- Job 26:14, “Lo, these are parts of his ways: but how little a portion is heard of him? but **the thunder of his power who can understand?**”

- Psalm 77:18, “The **voice of thy thunder** was in the heaven: the lightnings lightened the world: the earth trembled and shook.”

- Isaiah 29:6, “Thou shalt be visited of **YAHUAH of hosts with thunder**, and with earthquake, and great noise, with storm and tempest, and the flame of devouring fire.”
