
1st MONTH: "ABIB" (mid-Mar thru mid-Apr)



Purpose: A memorial remembering YAHUAH'S Deliverance and

Salvation for Israel as a nation out of Egypt's bondage, captivity and slavery. This Mow'ed (Feast Days) is about the unblemished Lamb's blood over the top and sides of the doors of our ancestor's houses, when the death angel passed over and through the land of Egypt that night, and smite all the firstborn both man and beast; and against all the elohai of Egypt, of which YAHUAH executed HIS judgment. This memorial also fulfill the prophecy of Yahusha (YAHUAH'S first and only begotten son) being our **Pesach/Passover** lamb that was sacrificed on the cruel stake, whereas the Son of Man, He shed His precious blood for the remission/ pardoning of our sins that we now be justified to partake in the **Renewed Covenant**.

In John 2:13-15, when Yahusha drove out the moneychangers out of the temple, a few days prior to Passover, it was also symbolic of "The search for leaven/sin and its removal, beginning in His Father's (YAHUAH'S) House! Yahusha was cleaning inside YAH'S Temple before the days of Unleavened Bread!

The Most High YAHUAH uses leaven to symbolize Sin, (1 Corinthians 5:1-8). Sin puffs up and grows within us spiritually just as physical leaven puffs up breaded dough. Unleavened bread symbolize a sinless life. We are to put leaven out of our homes and not eat it for seven days.

Feast: YAHUAH'S PESACH

(Also known as PASSOVER)

Number of days Feast of Pesach is observed: 1

(starts at sunset on the previous day & ends at sunset on the day of / no work on the day of Pesach)

How to Celebrate

Refer to - Seder (Passover Meal) ceremony in Exodus 12:1-28, for symbolic representation of the door post and the eating of the meal

The closer we get to Pesach, the more we should get ready for VAHUAWIS Deliverance and Salvation. Therefore, we're also to be in an exodus preparation state of mind as we Watch, Pray & Tarry for our Salvation and Deliverance from this Babylon captivity, and asking VIIIU/III to break all wicked spiritual and physical bondage of this Babylon system including that of our bloodline.

(Refer to Ezekiel 20:33-38)

Passover for Hebrew Israelites also represent and symbolize the ending of Easu (this wicked system) and "passing-over" to the beginning of YAHUAH'S Heavenly Kingdom with the restoration of Israel, therefore we know that YAHUAHIS Feast days are also observed in the heavens (see Jubilees 6:17)

How to Observe: Feast of Pesach (Symbolically & Physically)

Feast of Pesach is observed with joy and thanksgiving to YAHUAH, with remembering the sacrifice that was made for us before the foundation of the world, when Yahusha was slain of the Father, set-aside His Ruah (Spirit) and took on flesh (2nd Adam) to become the Son of Man; so that His Ruach Hakodesh would be given to us as a Gift called the Comforter, through whom we obtain Sanctification by the impartation of Yahusha's Perfect Righteousness,

(Hebrews 9:11-22 – Yahusha, the Unblemished Sacrifice is our Redemption).

Therefore; this is a season of Soul

searching and Repentance. Consequently, we are to be selfreflective of our thoughts, words and actions in accordance with YAHUAH'S Renewed Covenant, to

remove the leaven of sin from our lives. We are then to examine our lives and forgive offences as we ask YAHUAH to forgive our offences.

Also, with prayer and fasting **prior** to Pesach, asking YAHUAH to remove all leaven from our life, including the leaven of "self" that is in the flesh. Asking YAHUAH to release us from all wicked bondage of sin and to *cleanse*, *purge and purify* us so that we become whole, acceptable, and Set-Apart and a worthy living sacrifice that is pleasing to YAH, so that we may live righteously after the example of our Redeemer and King Yahusha

Hamashiach.

(Recommend/guide **Prior** to Pesach)

- 1- The closer we get to Pasach, the more we have to get ready/prepare ourselves for Deliverance and Salvation
- **2** *Fast & Prayer* to remove leaven from your heart. Ask forgiveness.
- **3** Spring Clean the House.
- **4** Remove leavened bread products, yeast, baking soda, sodium bicarbonate that cause bread product to rise.
- 5- Remember the improvised of the House of Israel, by identifying and assisting with genuine/legit needs on the days leading up to Pesach/Passover feast. (This may include, assisting, feeding or clothing for those in needs of the House of Israel and or donating to a righteous Hebrew Assembly).
- Isaiah 58:6-10 we are instructed (concerning the house of Israel) to loose bands of wickedness, undo heavy burdens, let oppress free, break yokes, feed the hungry, shelter the homeless and cloth the naked.
- 6- Items prepared: Lamb meat, Grill to cook lamb, bitter herb, kosher wine or grape juice, unleavened bread, a staff.
- **7** Symbolize the blood over the doors by using something red, such as red tape on the outside and, or red ribbon over the door on the inside of house.

Remark: The Mow'ed (Feast Days) are also when YAHUAH blesses, gift Israel; those that observe/learn HIS Covenant, and do HIS Laws, Statues and Commandants daily.

(Recommend/guide <u>On</u> of Pesach)

Refer to: Seder (Passover Meal)
Ceremony in accordance with
Exodus 12:1-28

- 1- Blow the shofar, eat grilled lamb, bitter herb & unleavened bread with Kosher wine or grape juice.
- 2- Eat meal standing up, with shoes on feet, a *staff* in hand and having the attitude of leaving Egypt/Babylon soon after.
- 3- Ceremoniously wash feet of Hebrew Israelites who are in the Set-Apart, redeemed in the Renewed Covenant by Yahushua.
- 4- Don't break the lambs bone or chew it with your teeth and the day after burn leftovers on the grill. (Remains of the Lamb meal must then be completely consumed with fire. None is to remain)
- 5- Family Bible Reading:

In the Scripture, YAHUAH has an appointed place and appointed time (Mow'ed) in the earth, where HE wants HIS Feasts, to be celebrated. During the Mow'ed (season) is also when the windows of heaven are opened and the treasures of the dew are opened in it for those in the nation of Israel/the remnant that are obedient (Observe and Do) to YAHUAH'S word, walking in the Renewed Covenant in the body of Yaushuah Hamarschich.

YAHUAH Will Restore Israel

Ezekiel 20:33-38 "As I live, says Adonai YAHUAH, surely with a mighty hand, and with a stretched out arm, and with fury poured out, will I rule over you: And I will bring you out from the people, and will gather you out of the countries wherein ye are scattered, with a mighty hand, and with a stretched out arm, and with fury poured out. And I will bring you into the wilderness of the people, and there will I plead with you face to face. Like as I pleaded with your fathers in the wilderness of the land of Egypt, so will I plead with you, says Adonai YAHUAH. 
YAH'S Appointed Time (Pesach/Passover)

Passover Prophecies

- Messiah in the tradition of the leaven removal.
- 2 Prophecy: Lamb was taken for each household according to the fathers and held from the 10th of Nisan to the 14th of Nisan. (4 Days)
- 3. How the lamb would arrive?
- Prophecy: Lamb was inspected over the four days and could not be found with spot or blemish.
- Prophecy: Lamb had to be kept until the 14th of Nisan and the whole congregation was to kill it
- Prophecy: The time that the Lamb would be nailed to the cross and the time the Lamb would die.
- 7. Prophecy: The Passover Sedar Songs to be sang
- 8. Prophecy: First Fruits Resurrection
- 9. Prophecy: The Bread Prophecy
- Prophecy: Counting of the Omer Preparation, The outpouring of the Holy Spirit, Writing the Law in our Hearts, Meeting God, The Wedding Ceremony.

YAHUAH'S PESACH/PASSOVER YAHUSHA IS THE PESACH LAMB THAT WAS SLAIN FROM THE FOUNDATIONS OF THE EARTH.

Rev 13:8

And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.

The PESACH/PASSOVER is fully manifested in the act of YAHUSHA being crucified on the stake for the remission of our sins.

The instructions and the details given about YAHUAH'S PESACH can be found in the Old Testament; Exodus 12. It can be seen how YAHUSHA came to fulfill the law and not to do away with the law. The following two scriptures give insight of how YAHUSHA is the lamb and how even leading up to the celebration of PESACH that he was keeping it even according to YAHUAH's law.

John 12:1-3

Six days before the Passover, YAHUSHA came to Bethany, the hometown of Lazarus, whom He had raised from the dead. 2 So they hosted a dinner for YAHUSHA there. Martha served, and Lazarus was among those reclining at the table with Him. 3 Then Mary took about a pint of expensive perfume, made of pure nard, and she anointed YAHUSHA' feet and wiped them with her hair. And the house was filled with the fragrance of the perfume.

The day was six days prior to PESACH, which would make it the 10th day of ABIB. The dinner was in honor of YAHUSHA and Lazarus was sitting next to Him. Mary served the meal and Martha further honored YAHUSHA by anointing His feet with expensive perfume and wiped it with her hair. Martha special care for YAHUSHA our LAMB, refers to Exodus 12:6 that talks about the special care of the sacrificial lamb until the evening of the fourteenth day of this first month.

In Exodus 12:3 the details are given to the Israelites on when, and how to choose a lamb for PESACH/PASSOVER match with the elements of that happened not the night of this dinner which is also called the Last Supper.
